- Recycle redemption bottles and cans,
- Non-redemption plastic containers and glass bottles,
- Mixed office paper, corrugated cardboard,
- Plastic film, light tubes,
- Cooking oil
- Food scraps are diverted through the Eco Feed program.
- Donate edible food to local non-profit food banks.
- Many of the products on shelves are packaged in boxes, bottles, cans and bags made from recycled content materials, as are some of the products themselves

## **Policies and Procedures**

- Team Members are encouraged to tread lightly on the earth and stay healthy by getting to work in some way other than driving a car.
- Have a bike rack near the front entrance
- The store is located on a number of bus lines
- Recently began an alternative transportation incentive program.
- Partner with suppliers to meet the growing demand for organic produce, eggs, meat, cheese, bread and packaged foods
- Educate Team Members and customers about the environmental benefits of Growing and producing organic foods
- All of the paper products sold are made from 100% chlorine-free recycledcontent fiber
- Cleaning products are biodegradable and phosphate-free

## **Community Outreach**

- At the Kahala Mall store a group of ten Team Members representing each department in the store works on environmental projects from energy conservation to Team Member education, alternative transportation, community involvement and recycling
- Every monthmembers of the Green Mission team assemble and post a list of educational and volunteer opportunities for Team Members
- Donate HI-5 bottles and cans to local schools and organizations for redemption
