Sustainability: Hokulani Waikiki is committed to caring for the environment as we opened the property as a LEED Certified in 2014. Starting with our clientele with 80% Japanese who are very in-tuned with the “green” culture, Hokulani Waikiki has made great steps to running a green business for the best interest of our guests and to care for our environment.

Hokulani Waikiki’s commitments:



Air conditioning systems have occupancy sensors to automatically shut off when no motion has been detected after a length of time.



Lobby glass doors to be shut during the day for AC efficiency



Back office and storage areas as well as public areas have occupancy sensors for lights



Energy Star rated electronics and appliances for all guest rooms and facilities.



In addition to our LED lighting conversions, vanity fluorescent lights were replaced by LED strip lighting during our soft goods renovations. The result will be from our current 74,434.36 kwh to 14,834.82 kwh, a savings total of 59,599.54 kwh.



Hot water heat exchanger between cooling tower water chiller and heat pump system



Recycling bags have been inserted to all guest rooms with instructions and to promote recycling.



Recycling bins have been installed on each floor, back of the house areas, offices, and guest facilities



Pool Bar stopped serving canned beers and only beers on taps.



Pool Bar serves beverages on reusable polycarbonate plasticwares instead of disposable cups



Access has picked up our paper wastes for recycling



All reusable hotel items such as furniture, kitchenware, building equipment, linen and towels were donated to local charities.



Scheduled soft goods renovations involved old furniture to be given to schools and liquidators to be resold



Thinned rolls toilet papers and paper towels from guest rooms and facilities have been used for back of the house paper products



Paper products with 30% or higher recycled content



Garden area (a.k.a. Hokulani Farms) was added by our employee break room to grow edible plants and replant plants deemed to be discarded.



Building materials due for discarding were repurposed for wall accent decorations



Pod-coffee makers were replaced for mesh filtered coffee brewers for less waste



Housekeeping cleaning products have been replaced with green friendly versions



Participated in a yearlong Project Search internship program for six students with learning disabilities. Mentoring students through various departments, providing hands-on experience to help prepare them to join the workforce.



Participated in Outrigger Hospitality's Ozone projects to help preserve our land which includes beach clean ups and promoting the Ozone Day event held at the Waikiki Aquarium.



For Hawaiian Cultural events, Hokulani participated in the Makalauna Celebration and the Aloha Festivals Royal Court Protocol at the Beachwalk.
