Ihilani Resort & Spa – Current Service:

- Plastic, glass, office paper, and newspapers collected in 95-gallon roll-out carts picked up weekly.
- Food Waste Recycling Services furnished by Eco-Feed.
- Green Waste disposed of on an as-needed basis by ROH.
- 30 cubic yard receiver box hauled one time per week. Open-top as needed for special projects.
- Trash is disposed of at H-Power, unless closed for repair and maintenance.
- Vertical baler used for baling cardboard. Bales picked up weekly.

IHILANI RECYCLES Results through November 2010:

Solid Waste disposed at H-Power and Waimanalo Gulch Landfill*: 299.10 tons

- Recycled: 62.18 tons
- 20.79% Recycling Rate
- Cardboard: 31.38 tons
- Office Paper: 1.70 tons
- Newspaper: 1.99 tons
- Glass: 26.93 tons
- Plastic: 0.18 tons
- Does not include Green Waste and Food Waste information

*NOTE: 21.86 tons were disposed of at the Landfill when H-Power was closed for overhaul and general maintenance work.
