

Sustainability Council Retreat by Kamehameha Schools



As part of the annual Sustainability Council retreat, Kamehameha Schools incorporated 25 sustainable practices, including paperless communications, reusable dishes, bring-your-own-bottle, and almost 100% local and/or organic menu. Kamehameha Schools has also begun to incorporate more robust recycling practices at the downtown Kawaiahao Plaza offices, known as the “Zero Waste KP” program. Efforts are also underway to develop energy, water, waste, carbon and agricultural baselines for Kawaiaha’o Plaza and the three main campuses on O’ahu, Maui and Hawai’i Island, aided in part by the first cohort of fellows in the new sustainability internship program.
