Sustainability Initiatives

Hawai'i Convention Center Overview

- ▶ Over 660,000 sq ft of space
- ▶ Approximately 250 events a year
- ▶ Approximately 500,000 people a year.



LEED GOLD v.4 O+M Existing Buildings certification

- ▶ July 2018 HCC became first public assembly, convention center in U.S. to earn LEED Gold v.4 O+M certification.
- ▶ Performance based approach calls for measurable results through building life cycle.
- ▶ Expands focus on materials, analyze impact to human health and environment.
- ▶ Evaluates total building water use.



Sustainability Initiatives

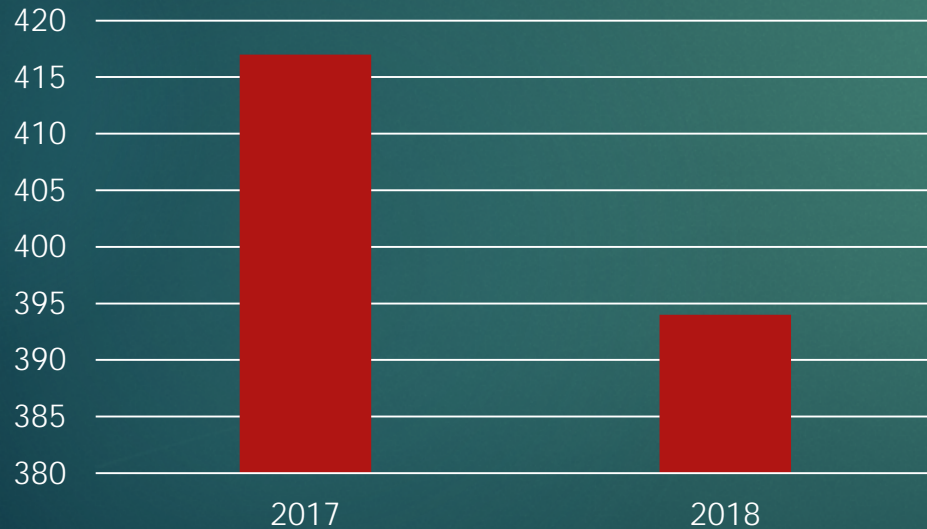
- ▶ LED Lighting Conversion
- ▶ Converting planters to artificial turf
- ▶ Water bottle filling stations
- ▶ Alternative Transportation



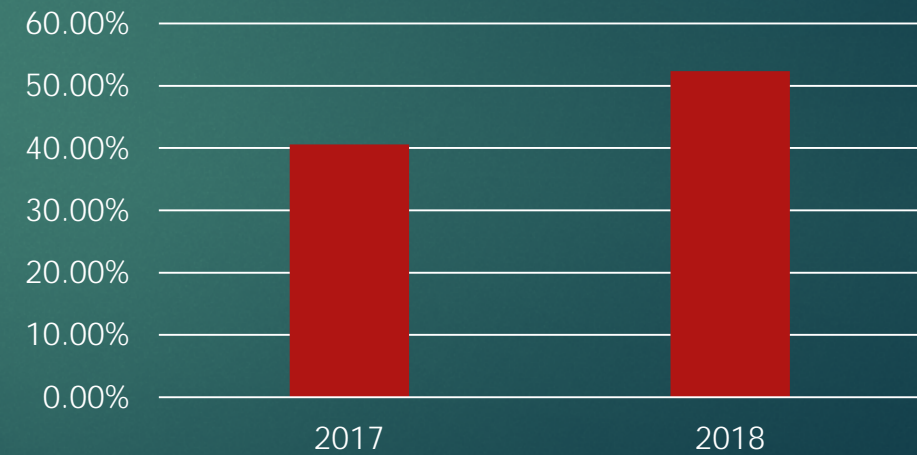
Waste Management

- ▶ Reduction of total waste: from 417 Tons to 394 tons
- ▶ Increased Diversion Rate: 41% to 52%

Recycling Program

- ▶ Advanced planning: Communicating months in advance with clients about event.
- ▶ Developed sustainability checklist for client. Recommendations on how to make their event more sustainable.
- ▶ Tailored recycling stations based on individual event.
