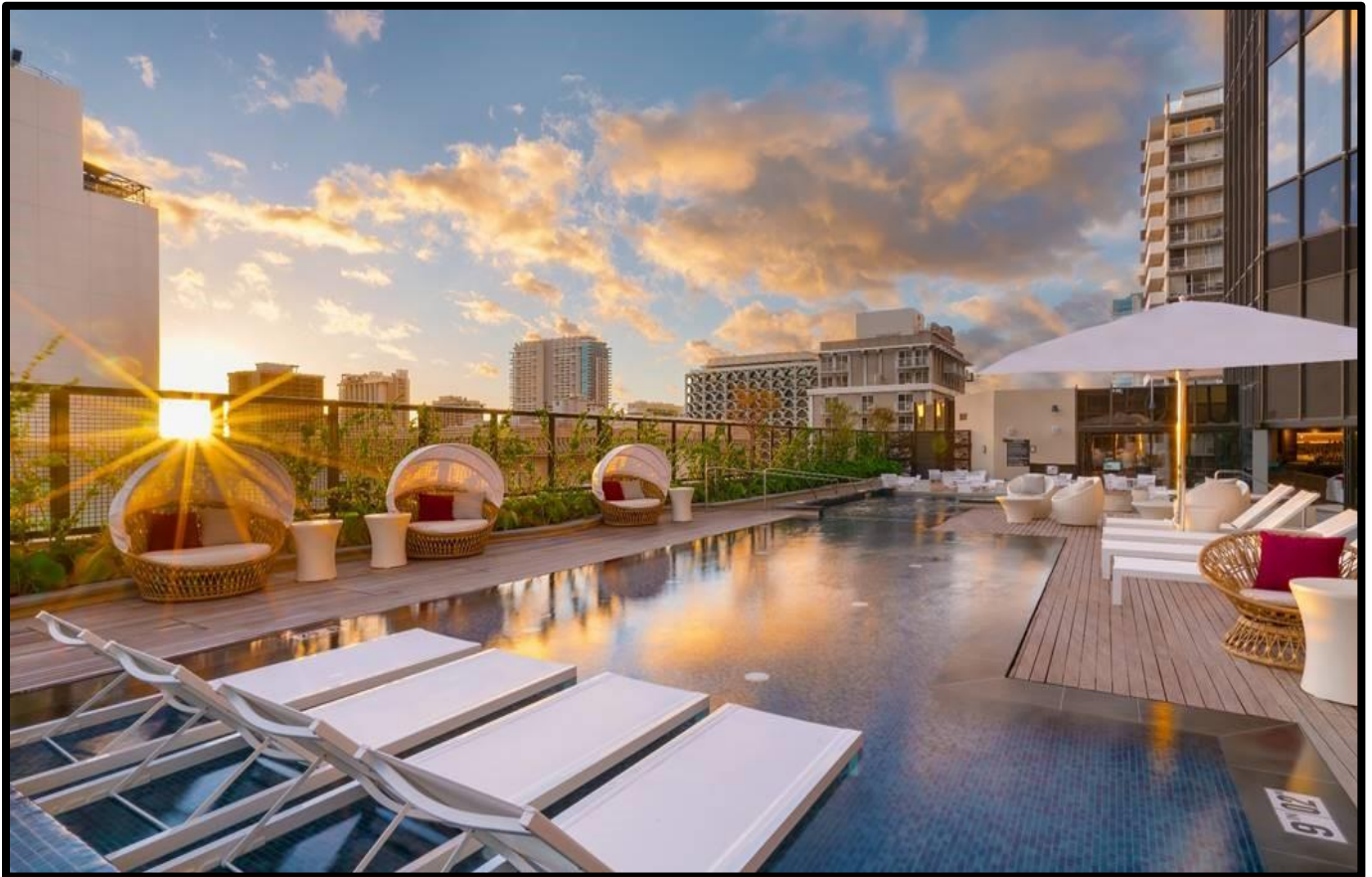




# HYATT CENTRIC<sup>®</sup>

With renovations completed in December 2016 and opening just days later, this explorer centric hotel offers guests a great launch pad from which they can explore the island. The Hyatt Centric Waikiki is dedicated to providing great service to those who are eco-conscious when traveling to keep their footprint as minimal as possible.

**The Hyatt Centric Waikiki's commitments:**



Converting from T8 Fluorescents to LED motion sensor lighting in emergency stairwells and the parking structure has reduced our energy consumption in those areas by 60%.



Parking Lighting reduced consumption by 109,000 kW/year



Stairwell Lighting reduced consumption by 33,500 kW/year



Providing a separate bin for bottles/cans makes it easy to recycle. Our housekeepers take the bottles/cans for reclamation and they keep the redemption.

Optional Linen Change: Previously we automatically changed linen on the third day. By changing over to an "on request" method, we have reduced our linen output by 18%. This means less water/electric for laundering and less fuel burned on transport.



Towel Reuse: As is common practice in the modern age, we encourage guests to reuse their towels. A towel left on the floor will be replaced.

Totally Green: Guests are offered the opportunity to opt out of daily service in exchange for a \$\$ credit.

- In 2018, this averaged 16.5 rooms/day or about 6,022 services in the year.
- Resulting in water and electricity savings
