Expanding Sustainability Initiative

Since 2016, Waialae Country Club has partnered with Sony Corporation, Friends of Hawaii Charities, Inc. and the State of Hawaii DBEDT to initiate a sustainable green program for the Sony Open In Hawaii.

Last year, Waialae Country Club expanded its initiatives by including our very own program to highlight our best practices by continuing to strive to conserve and protect our natural resources, minimize our waste and pollution, and raise environmental awareness within our organization, employees and members.

Installation of cardboard baler

To eliminate waste and promote our efforts to recycling. WCC purchased a cardboard baler, which compresses cardboard material for recycling.

- Significant savings per month, approximately \$1000 per month
- Reduced waste pick-up, 1 less dumpster per week
- Average 5-6 bales of cardboard picked-up weekly for recycling. 1 unit = 188 lbs of cardboard



Cartbarn & Golf Shop Photovoltaic Energy Installation

- Completed installation of 112.26 kw AC photovoltaic system
- PV system is expected to produce about 186,048 kw of electricity
- Estimated a first year savings of \$13,000.00 at \$.21 per kwh

Solid Waste Reduction and Recycling

- Converted from plastic straws and coffee stirrers to paper or compostable content
- Purchase recycled content materials and green friendly products
