- 2018 Hotel renovation Hawaii Energy Rebates
 - New guestroom refrigerator
 - New AC controls EMS (INNCOM)
 - New VAV controls for public area air handlers
 - Guestroom LED lighting
 - New pool VFD pump system
 - Installed solar powered window shades for all guest rooms







Completed Projects

- 4th floor Aquaponics/Hydroponics Urban Garden
- Replaced existing electric pool heaters with new gas powered heaters for the pools/jacuzzi and received our Hawaii Gas rebate.
- Implemented our "Energy Akamai" program to teach our employees hands on experience on how to replace their lights with energy efficient bulbs and how to replace their shower heads/faucet aerators with low flow aerators to reduce their water consumption.
- Our goal was to show how energy conservation can save them money at home and at work to change their energy mindset.
- Currently working on our Chiller Optimization project which was funded from the Hawaii Energy rebate program.







Completed Projects

- Replaced our original (1990) rooftop guest corridor (4) air with new Ventus air handlers with VFDs optimal performance.
- Upgraded our hotel's EV charging stations and installed 2-EV chargers at the golf course funded by Hawaii Energy's rebate.
- Replaced original walk in refrigerators for the Main Kitchen's Garde Manger, Butcher Shop, Pantry, Main Kitchen Entry and Golf Course Clubhouse with high efficiency walk-in refrigerator/freezers.
- Replaced original High Zone Hot water storage tank (800 gals) with (4) High Efficiency Gas Hot water Heaters.
- Reduced our gas consumption by not having to preheat the 800 gals of hot water as the hot water is directly supplied to the guest rooms from the high efficiency hot water heaters.








Sustainable Tourism
