











Background:

For more than a decade, Hawai'i Energy has empowered island residents and business to make smart energy choices. As a key player in the local energy industry with an ongoing mission to tackle one of the most critical components of our state's 100% clean energy transition, environmental sustainability is at the core of Hawai'i Energy's operations. While its slate of services for customers primarily involves incentivizing and encouraging energy efficiency actions like equipment upgrades, the program also recognizes the deeply intertwined connections between energy and water, recycling, transportation, and other elements of natural resource preservation. Hawai'i Energy works closely with its employees, customers, and other organizations to support market transformation efforts at both small and large-scales, from supporting development of the "green workforce" to advocating for systemic, statewide sustainability changes addressed by public policy.

Highlights:

- More than 75% of the office equipment, refrigerators, and dishwasher are Energy Star certified products.
- Encourage commuter alternatives by informing employees, customers & others, about transportation options. Post bicycle route maps, bike sharing service map, transit schedules, or commuter ride sign-ups in a visible area for employees.
- Property irrigation is tested to prevent leaks and adjusted according to the season.
- Provide space for In-office recycling of cardboard, mixed paper, newspapers, office paper and aluminum cans.
- LED lighting with occupancy sensors throughout the office. Lighting controls are checked and adjusted annually.
