Background:

The Westin Nanea Ocean Villas' three foundational pillars are culture, community, and sustainability. The property continues to be involved in numerous eco-friendly initiatives and projects that have earned the resort LEED Gold certification for new construction in 2018. More recent energy efficiency projects include instant Domestic Hot Water Heating, Cogeneration Plant, Condensed Water Pump Resizing, and expanding the EV car charging stations for guests and associates.

Highlights:

- Conversion of hot water heating to instant/on-demand with Heat Exchangers
- CoGeneration plant generating electricity and heat by-product is recaptured to heat pools, spas, and domestic hot water
- Condensed water pump resizing from 125 hp to 50 hp
- Expanding EV car charging from 2 to 6 stations
