
Highlights:

- Ko Olina's water use decreased 86,227 gallons from 2023 to 2024
- Rain sensors installed on irrigation watering stations
- Storm drain signage to encourage people to not dispose of anything down the drains
- Installation of lanai door sensors. When lanai doors open, air conditioning is automatically turned off until lanai doors have been re-closed
- Signage in rooms to encourage guests to conserve water and energy
- Replacing of LED lighting instead of halogen lighting in our large Koi pond
- Replacing LED lights for incandescent and halogen lighting in public areas
- Replacing outdated pool heaters with 98% energy efficient pool heaters
- Replacing pump motors with more-efficient, Variable Frequency Drive motors
- Using electric landscaping equipment in lieu of gas-powered
