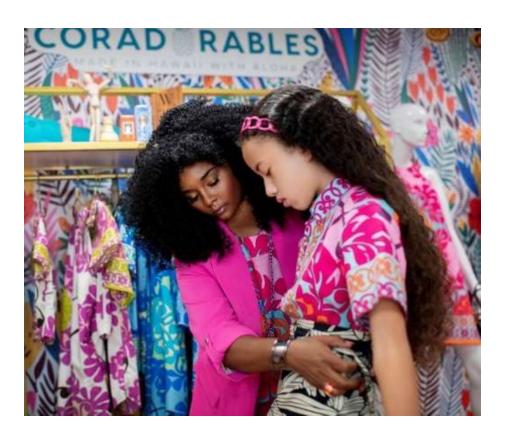

Background:

Coradorables is proud to be Hawai'i's first product-based certified B Corporation, dedicated to sustainability and ethical practices. Their heirloom-quality matching resort wear is made locally in Hawai'i, supporting over 15 women-led businesses and ensuring a clean supply chain. By prioritizing eco-friendly materials and production methods, they create beautiful pieces for families globally while minimizing our environmental impact and fostering community collaboration.

Highlights

- Exceptional B Corporation Status: In 2023, Coradorables became Hawai'i's first product-based certified B Corporation, achieving an outstanding transparency score of 107.7, placing them in the top 10% of B Corps worldwide. With only 7,000 certified B Corps globally and an average score of 80, their commitment to high social and environmental performance reflects dedication to transparency and sustainability in every aspect of the business.
- Sustainable Materials: Prioritizing the use of eco-friendly fabrics, such as organic cotton and recycled materials, ensuring products are both beautiful and environmentally conscious.
- Local Production: All resort wear is designed and manufactured in Hawai'i, significantly reducing transportation emissions and supporting the local economy.
- Energy Efficiency: Source energy from renewable sources and utilize energy-efficient machinery in production facilities to reduce the carbon footprint.
- Zero Waste Practices: Coradorables implements a zero-waste approach by repurposing fabric scraps and producing items that maximize material efficiency, diverting waste from landfills.
- Recycling Initiatives: Actively engage in recycling programs for packaging and production materials, ensuring that waste is minimized and materials are reused whenever possible.
- Community Engagement: Commitment to sustainability extends beyond products; hosting workshops, speaking nationally and collaborating with national organizations to educate various communities on sustainable practices globally.
- Logistics Optimization: Optimizing supply chain to minimize transportation emissions by sourcing materials locally and managing efficient delivery systems.
- Certifications and Transparency: As a certified B Corporation, certified WBENC woman owned and certified Disability IN, they continuously assess social and environmental impact, striving for transparency in processes and materials.
- Carbon Offsetting: Investing in carbon offset programs, contributing to reforestation and clean energy projects to mitigate environmental impact further.
- Investment in Supima Cotton: Coradorables proudly invests in Supima cotton, a premium, trademarked cotton variety grown exclusively in the USA. Comprising only 3% of the world's cotton production, Supima offers superior softness, strength, and color retention, making it an ideal choice for athleisure collection. By sourcing this exceptional material, they not only support domestic agriculture but also ensure that products meet the highest standards of quality and sustainability, providing customers with luxurious, long-lasting apparel.

 practices and develop solutions that address environmental challenges in retail on a national scale.
