











Background:

Founded in 2005, **Maui Brewing Company** is Hawai'i's largest craft brewery. MBC is based on Maui, with its grid-independent production brewery, restaurant and tasting room in Kīhei, as well as restaurants in Ka'anapali (Maui), Kailua (O'ahu), and Waikīkī (O'ahu). Maui Brewing Co. is dedicated to brewing premium beverages in the most sustainable way possible, including fan-favorite year-round brews and specialty limited-release releases.

Highlights:

- 1.2MW array of solar panels cover the building's roof, awning, and carports.
- Solar thermal systems reduce propane gas consumption by approximately 50% for water heating needs.
- Solar PV with Tesla battery storage provides approximately 100% of power needs at the 85,000 square foot facility.
- Biodiesel generators fueled by locally produced biodiesel provide makeup and backup power as needed vs. grid power.
- Reduction of CO2 emissions by more than 2,000,000 pounds per year through combined sustainability efforts.
- Producing ~60% of CO2 on-site; recovered 500,000 lbs of CO2 from being vented into the atmosphere and adding more capacity to grow beyond 100%.
- One of the first craft breweries to package in recyclable aluminum cans, the #1 recycled beverage container in the US. Canning line fills & seams approximately 500 cans per minute. Products packaged in pulp board containers.
- Spent grain donated to local farmers.
- Team highway and beach cleanups.
- Used grain bags donated for environmental clean-ups in Maui County by partnering with Malama Maui Nui, Hawai'i Wildlife Fund, and Pacific Whale Foundation.
